

### PASTOR'S PAGE



As I write this, it is becoming real to me that December will be our last month together. With that in mind, I hope we can make it a wonderful Advent and Christmas season!

Our children will be assisting us this year as we prepare our hearts for Christmas by introducing the theme for each of the candles we light. There will be a short skit, then a litany for the congregation. The children will then lead us as we sing "Away In A Manger," helping us to keep looking forward to the day we celebrate Jesus' birth.

Our Choir will also help us prepare for Christmas. The Choir Cantata will be Dec. 11. This is always a special Sunday in Advent, and I hope for many of us to be there to be led by them in song.

Christmas Eve will feature 2 worship services. The first will be at 5 pm and will be designed for children and families. The second will be at 7 pm and will be our Candlelight service. Of course, there is no requirement to attend either service – both are open to anyone who wishes to worship at that time.

We will meet at 9 am on Saturday, Dec. 3 to decorate the sanctuary. This is always a lot of fun, and open to all ages. Somehow, treats always arrive at the same time, so come to help decorate and to enjoy Christmas snacks.

It is still hard to imagine that this will be our last month together. I sometimes wonder at the wisdom of the Holy Spirit, when she stirs our hearts to move in a direction that we never imagined. At the same time, I also know that the Holy Spirit has not let me down in the past, so I can't imagine why it would do so now. I also know that Zion will be OK as you prepare for a new pastor. Zion has been in Glendive for over 100 years, caring for its members and for the community. I pray that Zion will still be here 100 years from now still nurturing the faith of its members and reaching out to the community. I know I was fortunate to be here for the 3+ years that I was your pastor. We endured Covid, worked together to worship and to serve others, and had a lot of fun doing God's work in Glendive. The strength of any congregation is its members, and Zion has members that are committed to growing in faith and in caring for its neighbors. That will keep you going as you work together to prepare for the next pastor and as you receive this new pastor and grow to love them.

My goal has never been to be the best pastor you have ever had. Instead, it has been to be the best pastor you need at this particular time. In the same way, your next pastor will be just who you need for the time that they are here. I hope you love them just as much (maybe even more!) than you have loved me. I pray you are open to learning from them, working with them and exposing them to the uniqueness of Glendive and its people.

Please pray for me as I enter the unknown territory of the call as the Associate to the Bishop. I know that I will constantly pray for you as you work through the interim time between now and when your next pastor arrives!


#### **KUDOS TO ZION KIDS**

#### A letter from Allen Hansen LPA/FIC Board Member:

As a member of the Freedom in Christ Prison Ministry Board, I wish to express my personal gratitude for the continuing contributions Zion Lutheran and the Women of the ELCA have made to keep this important ministry viable.

Since the onset of Covid, FIC has been challenged to maintain contact with inmates. Pastor Rob has been regularly called when inmates request counseling, experience bereavement, or are dying and pass. But regular worship, Bible study, and volunteer visitations are negatively impacted and oftentimes cancelled on short notice due to staff shortages and restrictive Montana State Prison policies. Pastor Rob works in an almost constantly tense environment.



#### Youth sales-

The youth will be selling t-shirts and sweatshirts with the Zion Lutheran name on them. All sales will be final as of December 4<sup>th</sup>. There are three colors to choose from grey, marine green, and navy. Price is determined by what style you would prefer. There are order blanks in the coffee area of the church. Our church is an important part of the community and we want people to recognize who we are. For every sale a dollar will be donated to the cancer society. November 9, 2022 7:00 p.m. Fellowship Room

Call to Order: President Kevin M. Called the meeting to order.

**Devotions:** Pastor Frelsi conducted the devotions.

Secretary's Report: Steve moved, seconded by Rita to approve the minutes of October 12, 2022. The motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: Steve presented the financial report as of October 22. Bill H. moved, seconded by Don Z. to approve the

report.

Pastor's Report: The second family night was well-received, and better attended. The next one is "Breakfast for Dinner". Pastor preached at the Methodist Church, as well as at Zion, on Reformation Sunday. She is hoping to secure new LPA's. Advent begins on November 27. The children will have a part in the candle lighting, in place of the Children's sermon. There will be two Christmas Eve Services this year, plus a 10:00 a.m. one on Christmas Day. Pastor will be

Traveling to see Sarah and the new baby Dec. 12-17. She may cancel worship on Dec. 15, or have someone read her sermon for the 18<sup>th</sup>. Decorating for Advent is Saturday, Dec. 3, at 10:00 a.m. Ministry actions: Funeral for Gary Schlenz.

GMC worship participants may have more that aren't Lutheran. A letter of resignation from Pastor was distributed. Pastor's last day at Zion will be December 25, as she has accepted the call from the Montana Synod to be the Associate to the Bishop, as of January 1, 2023.

**Communications:** A letter was read from NRIT, which provides continuing education classes for pastors and lay people. They request that this service be included in our annual budget. No action taken. Oakland Insurance provides "Church Mutual" insurance, which will cost \$139/ month. There are no other options available for our church.

#### **Committee Reports:**

**Property & Management** (Vern, Steve M., Bill M. Don Z.) A leaf sweeper has been purchased. The boiler has not been checked yet.

Evangelism & Stewardship (Penny Z., Rita H., Kristie S., Kevin) No report

Social Ministry (Rita F., Brian C., Adele) No report

Youth & Education (Nancy K., Bill H., Norm U., Danielle W.) The youth will be selling t-shirts and sweatshirts.

There have been two Family Nights. They are reviewing their goals.

Worship (Norm, Gail) Decorating for Advent will take place on Saturday, Dec. 3 at 10:00 a.m.

Old Business: Work continues to replace openings on the council. An executive committee consisting of Kevin, Steve M., Gail, and Adele will be devising the 2023 Budget. Steve M. moved, seconded by Norm to accept the "Church Mutual" proposal, and to complete payments monthly. A thank you to Avis Anderson was signed, for her funding the Prayer Garden cleanup, and for the lights for the bushes. Since the Pastor will be leaving, Norm recommended there be an audit. Don Z., Don Idso, and Deb Schwartz did the last "Internal audit".

**New Business:** Temple talk for November will be shared by Steve M. and Nancy Korb. A letter of resignation from Vicki Ulrich, Church Secretary, was distributed. Her last day will be Dec. 27<sup>th</sup>. Steve moved, seconded by Rita to accept her resignation. The motion passed. Discussion was held on a job description, for the secretary, and for Steve M., treasurer, to have the checkbook that has been kept in the church office. Also, the topic of having two credit cards was discussed.

Discussion, in the absence of Pastor Frelsi, was entertained to allow her to have the laptop purchased by Zion, to allow her to store her belongings in the parsonage until as she is able to come and get them. Zion will pay the utilities for

the parsonage. Steve moved to pay her benefits to January 1, so there will not be a gap in coverage. The motion passed. The next meeting will be at 6:00 p.m. on December 14, in order to have a zoom meeting with the Bishop.

The meeting was Adjourned with the Lord's Prayer and Zion's Mission Statement.
