

MISSION STATEMENT: As a body of believers, created by God, redeemed by Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit, we are called to bear witness to God's love.

CALL TO ORDER: President Cindy Gabbert called the meeting to order.

SECRETARY REPORT: Steve/ Don moved to approve the report as written.

TREASURER REPORT: Kristie/ Susan moved to approve the report as written.

LPA'S REPORTS:

Norm: Did "Blessing of the Bikes", Confirmation Class, visitations at Grandview & Heritage, baptism, worship service and affirmation of baptism, attended Synod Assembly and LPA Gathering.

Nancy: Led the evening service the first 3 Thursdays of the month, and is scheduled through August.

COMMUNICATIONS: Chamber of Commerce invitation to Social and Award presentation at the Bloom; Thank You from Luther's Lodge in Billings; KGLE's announcement of free service for Zion's events or outreach; ELCA World Hunger; Global Refuge; New Life Ministries; and Montana Bible College.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

PROPERTY & MANAGEMENT (Vern D. Steve M., Bill M., Don Z.) MT Plumbing replaced floor drain piping which had been causing odor; Replacement of fans and ceiling repair is planned. Kyle Robinson construction has replaced rear entry door and 3 basement windows at the parsonage. Working with Doug Baker for new flooring on stairs to parsonage basement. Mowing: Bill Miller through May; Steve M.- June; and Bob Stanhope- July. Bill M. spread weed & feed. Rich Lindgren continues to maintain the parsonage lawn, and requests some tree/ brush removal. No word on cost estimate for backup electric generator for the church. Have contact with contractor to possible install/replace rain gutters. Had another contact with Hansen Heating to develop boiler control system. No movement on seeking approval for drawing up a rental agreement for use in renting the parsonage when we have a pastoral vacancy. (Monthly fee, provide utilities or not, pets or not, deposit, etc.)

EVANGELISM & STEWARDSHIP (Penny Zimmerman, Kristie Stanhope, Kevin & Susan Miller) Zion served breakfast for the Makoshika Buzzard Day.

SOCIAL MINISTRY: (Dave Weidner, Adele I., Deric H.) ZLCW has been serving funerals. Loaves & Fishes/ Salvation Army, and the Furniture Room continue to meet the needs of the community. The bounteous Mother's Day potluck was enjoyed by about thirty.

YOUTH & EDUCATION: (Norm U., Megan K., Jaylene S.) Plans for 2024-25 Sunday School 9:00-9:45 am (for up through fifth grade) continue. Being considered: Family Night.

CALL COMMITTEE (LaNette Simonton, Tracy Gabbert, Dave Senvold, Danielle Wold, Norm Unterseher, Christina Sager) No progress. Pastor Brenda continues to search, as the Bishop is on sabbatical leave for two months.

NEW BUSINESS: VBS for K- Gr.6 will be June 24-27 from 9:00 am- 2:00 pm., with 3-4 counselors from Badlands Ministries. Theme is "I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. SYNOD CONVENTION REPORT: 36 MT congregations are seeking a pastor. In 2019, 358 candidates graduated to become a pastor. In 2023, only 153 graduated to serve the entire United States. Don/ Kristie moved to adjourn. Motion carried.
