

Zion Lutheran Church Women
Scholarship Guidelines for College Student Application

1. A scholarship is provided by Zion Lutheran Church Women to a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Glendive, MT. who is a graduating senior or presently attending an accredited college or university. Applications are available in the fellowship room and on the Zion Lutheran website.
2. The scholarship is in the amount of \$500 and is paid to the college of your choice or to a Lutheran seminary.
3. Most Lutheran colleges will match this scholarship.
4. The application must be submitted with two (2) letters of reference: one reference being a faculty member of the school from which the student graduated (or is graduating) and the second reference being an employer or general reference. Neither reference is to be related to the applicant.
5. Include a transcript of your grades with this application.
6. This scholarship will be awarded to the college or higher education school in accordance with the regulations of the college or school where the applicant has been accepted.
7. A typed essay of 500 words is to be submitted describing future plans, why you have decided to attend this particular college and your financial need,. Include any other financial aid you will be receiving or that you are seeking.
8. Deadline for this application is **___March 19, 2023___**. (Deadline may be modified or waived by Zion Lutheran Church Women from year to year or under special circumstances.)
9. This scholarship may be renewable for each year attending college. Application must be made each successive year.
